Abby Cohen is Co-Founder and Co-CEO of Sparo, an award-winning, digital health company dedicated helping people breathe better, be more active, and live happier. Abby was named to the Forbes 2017 30 Under 30, Healthcare List. In 2015, Abby and Andrew were selected to represent Sparo as 1 of 30 companies from across the U.S. to exhibit at the first-ever White House Demo Day. They have presented for the Cavendish Global Health Impact Forum at the United Nations in New York, as well as at The University of Oxford. Abby and Andrew have also won 10 of 12 technology, public health, and business competitions they entered as students, which ranged from the regional to international stage, resulting in \$275,000 in grant competition winnings.

Abby was a Pipeline Fellow in 2013 and remains an active member in Pipeline, an exclusive community of entrepreneurial leaders building high-growth companies in the midwest region. Abby is also civically engaged. She is currently co-chairing the \$10 million Evolve Capital Campaign with George Paz, President of the Board of Express Scripts, to further develop T-Rex, downtown St. Louis's innovation center. Abby serves as an Executive Board Member (2nd Vice President) and chair of the Rising Leaders Committee for the St. Louis Chapter of the Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America and is Member of the Cranbrook Educational Community Innovation Advisory Committee.
